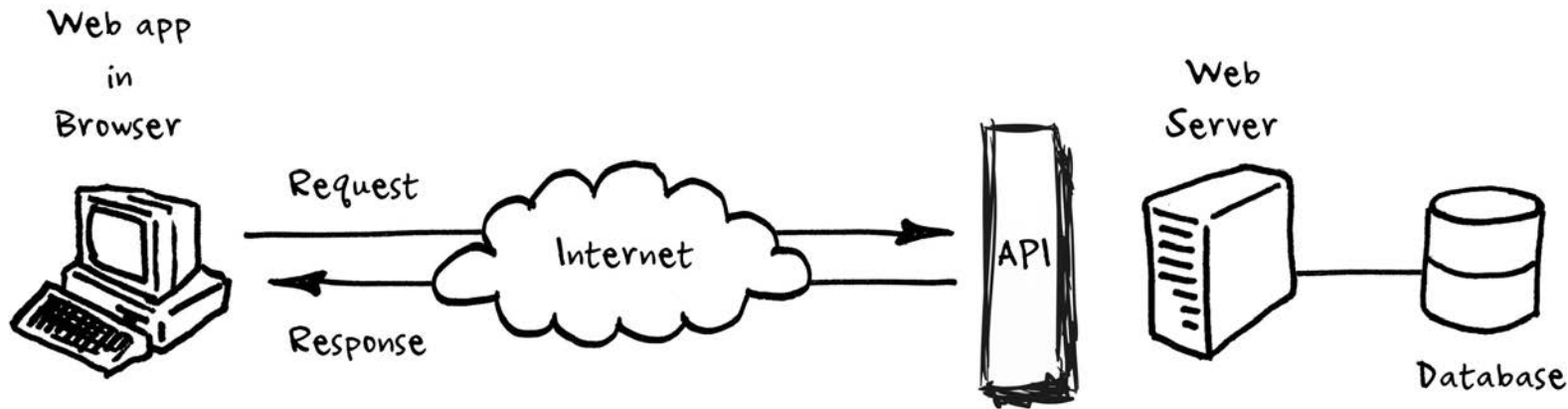


What is “The Cloud”?

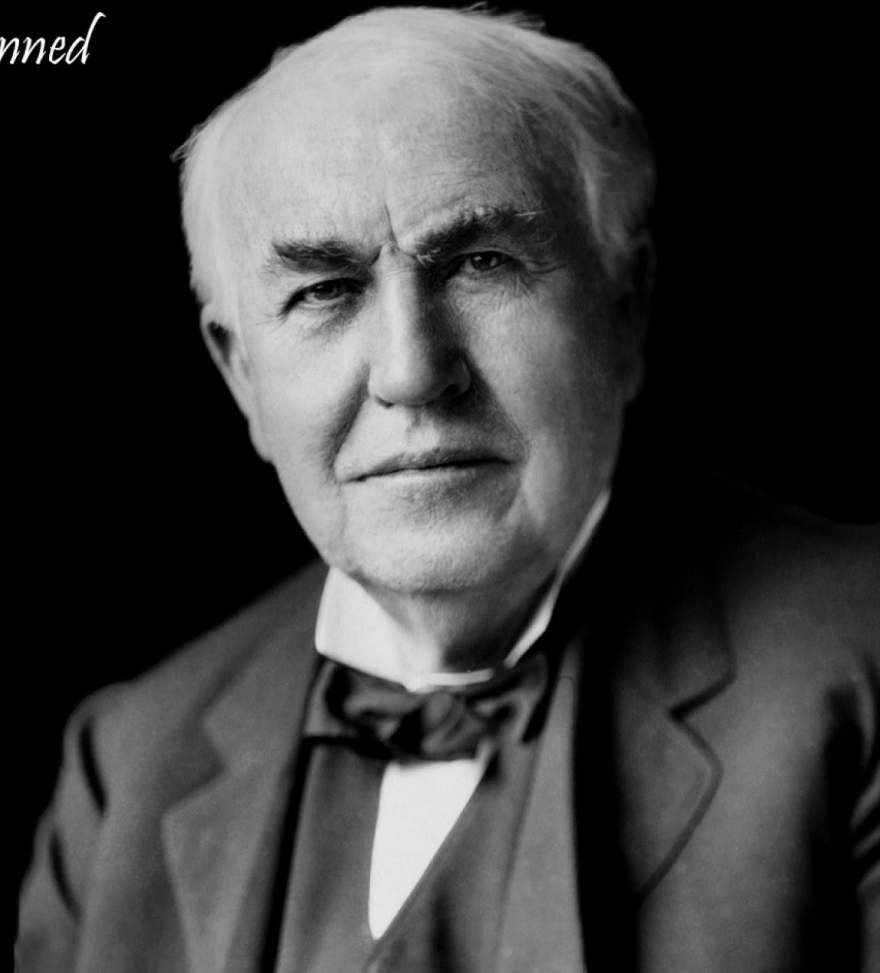
“A model for enabling ubiquitous, convenient, on-demand network access to a shared pool of configurable computing resources (e.g. networks, server, storage, applications, and services) that can be rapidly provisioned with minimal effort (by either users or provider).”

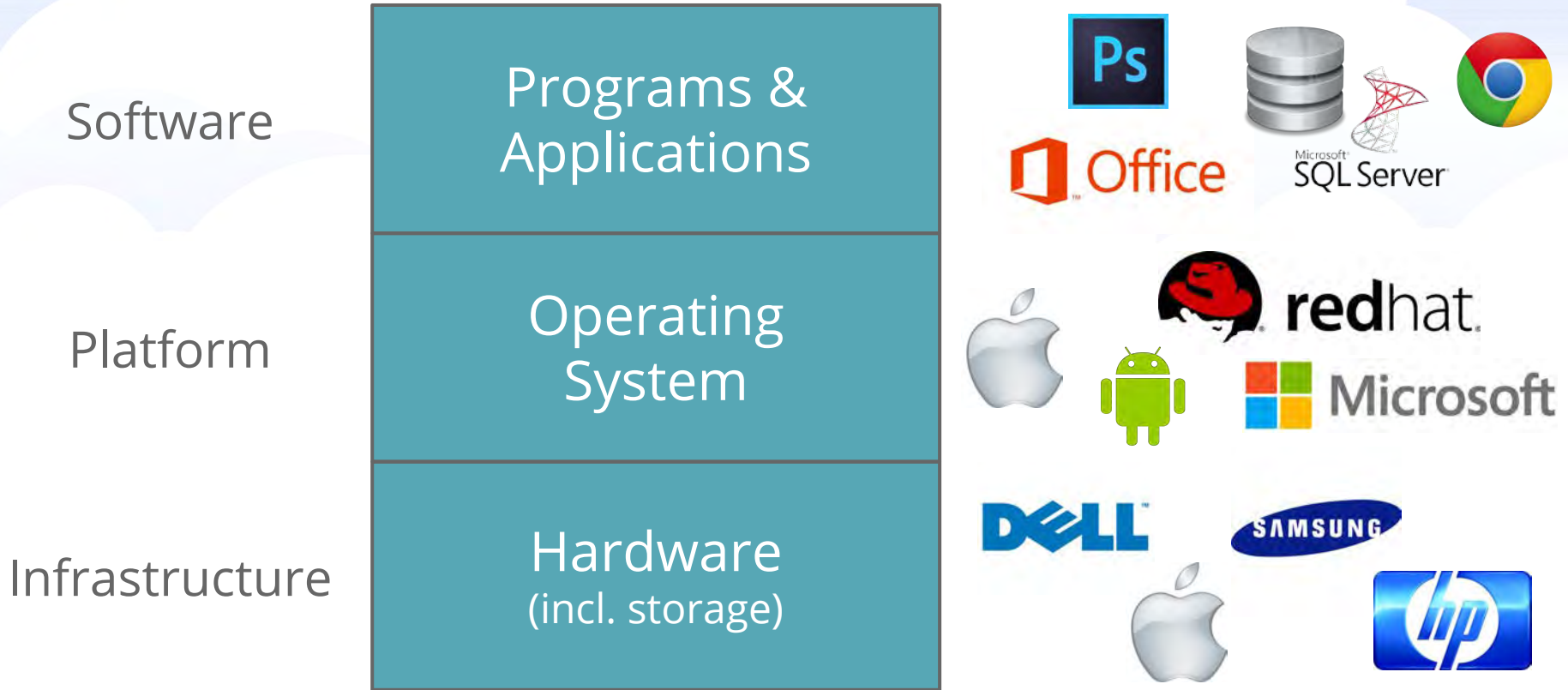

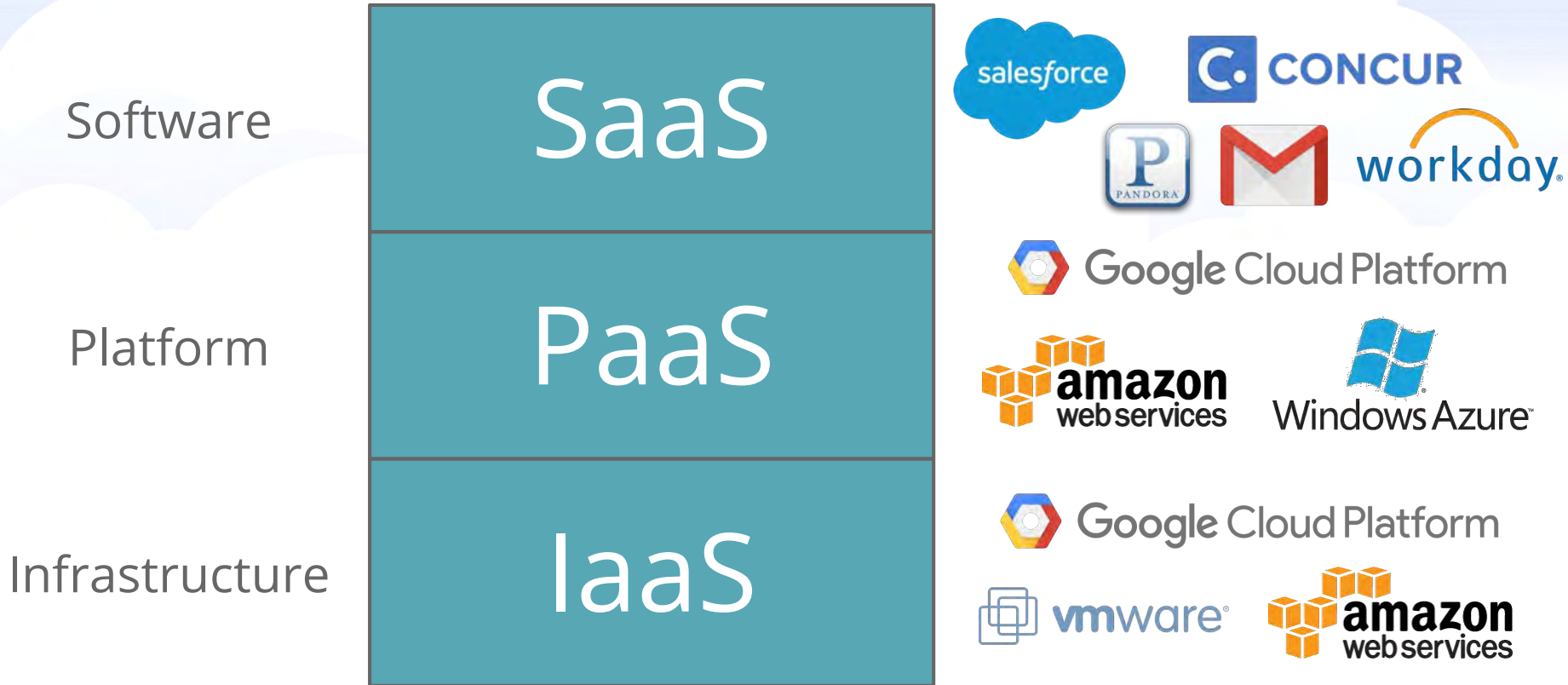

Systems designed to provide encrypted, global redundancy by default - eliminating "backups" and "failover systems"





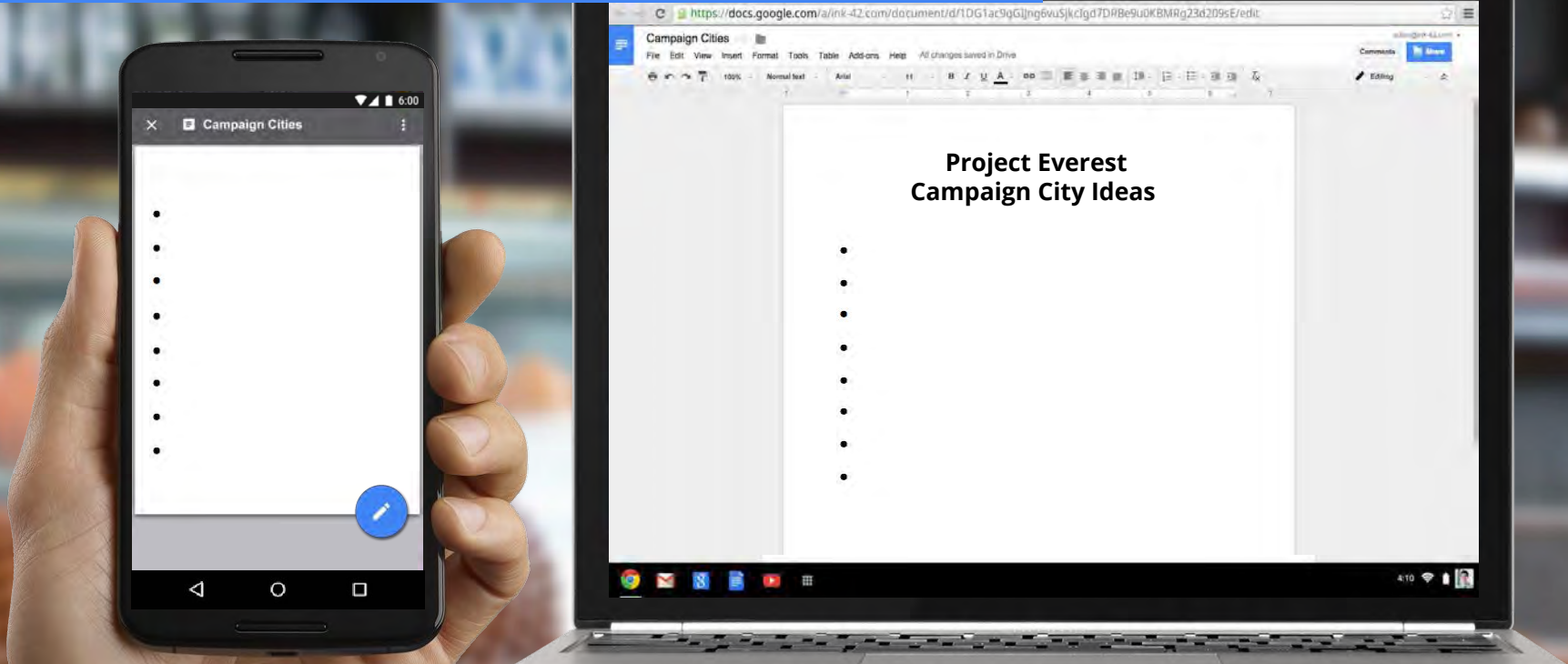
## Elastic and Unlimited

# Universal Collaboration
