We are excited to share this flower guide with you as you embark on your wedding-planning journey! We hope it inspires you to dream up possibilities for your big day and provides you with valuable wedding floral information.

The floral process...

- Research reputable wedding florists (those who specialize in weddings; not all florists do)
 - ~ Read reviews on Wedding Wire & The Knot
 - ~ Look at website; are images up-to-date with wedding trends?
 - Read their blog—is it current and helpful?
- Schedule consultations with 1-3 wedding florists 6-9 months prior to your wedding
 - ~ If your wedding falls on a holiday weekend, meet 9-12 month prior
- Plan on up to 2 hours for your initial consultation (most last 1-2 hours)
 - Bring color swatches, a picture of your gown, your bridesmaid's gown and pictures
 of flowers you love as well as insights in to your overall wedding vision (food,
 invitation, music, etc)
- Review proposals. Compare quantity and quality before costs; if proposals are not "apples for apples" the price will be hard to compare
- Hire a wedding florist within 1-2 weeks of meeting to lock in pricing and availability (wedding florists are on a first come, first served basis and you don't want to lose your opportunity). You will sign an agreement and pay an initial fee to hire a florist
- Finalize (provide final head counts, table counts, color and flower choices) the flower order 2-4 weeks prior to your wedding and pay any remaining balance

Boutonniere — A floral piece worn by a man on his lapel

Cascade — A bouquet style where the flowers hang and trail down from a plastic and foam handle

Chuppah — A 3-dimensional square structure for the ceremony

Compote — A footed bowl-like container used for centerpieces

Corsage — A floral piece worn by women either on the chest (pin on) or wrist (wristlet)

Foilage — Assorted greens

Handfied — A bouquet style where the flowers are left on the stems and grouped together

Halo — A crown made of foliage and/or flowers

Nosegay — A bouquet style where the flowers are kept tight and is small

Pipe and Drape — A background made of fabric hanging from a metal structure

Pomander — A round foam ball adorned with flowers and ribbon.

Swag — A vertical or horizontal presentation of flowers, usually used at ceremonies
